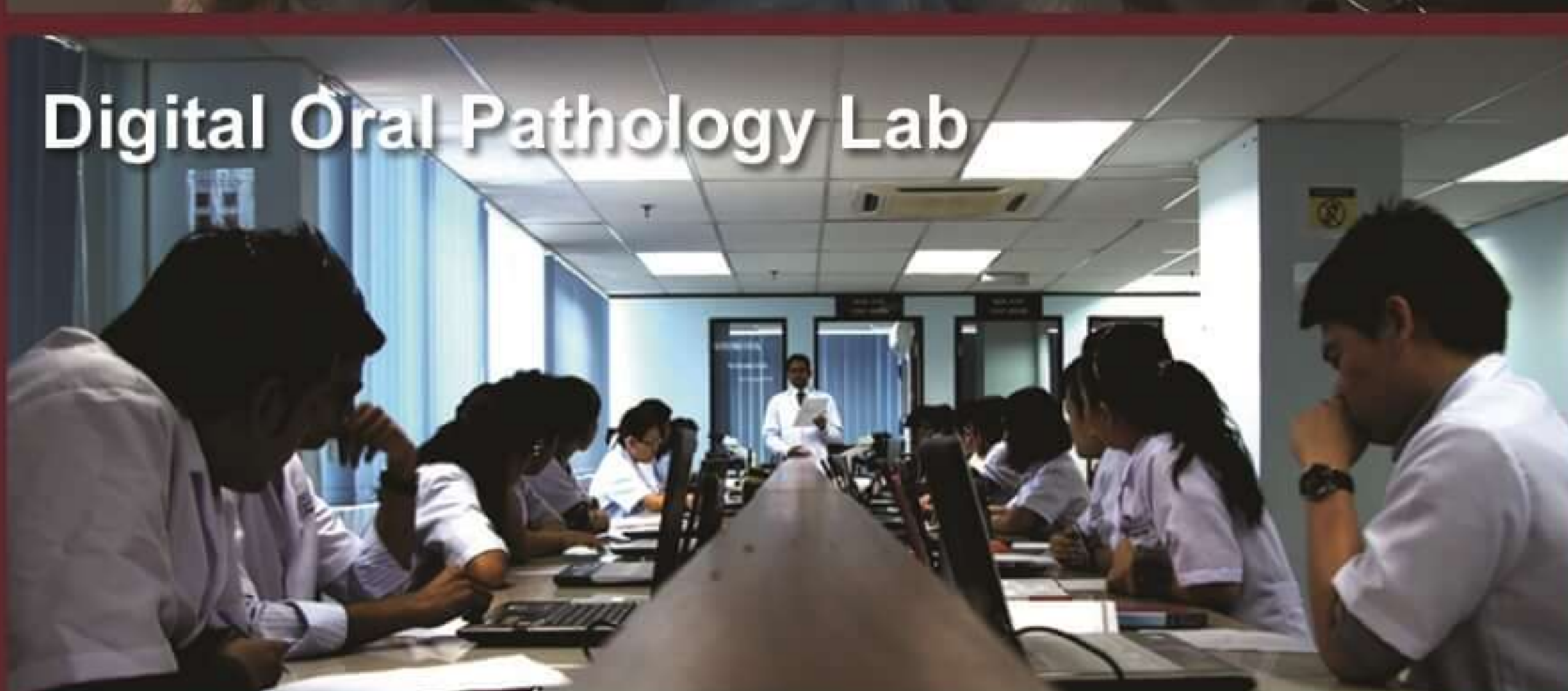

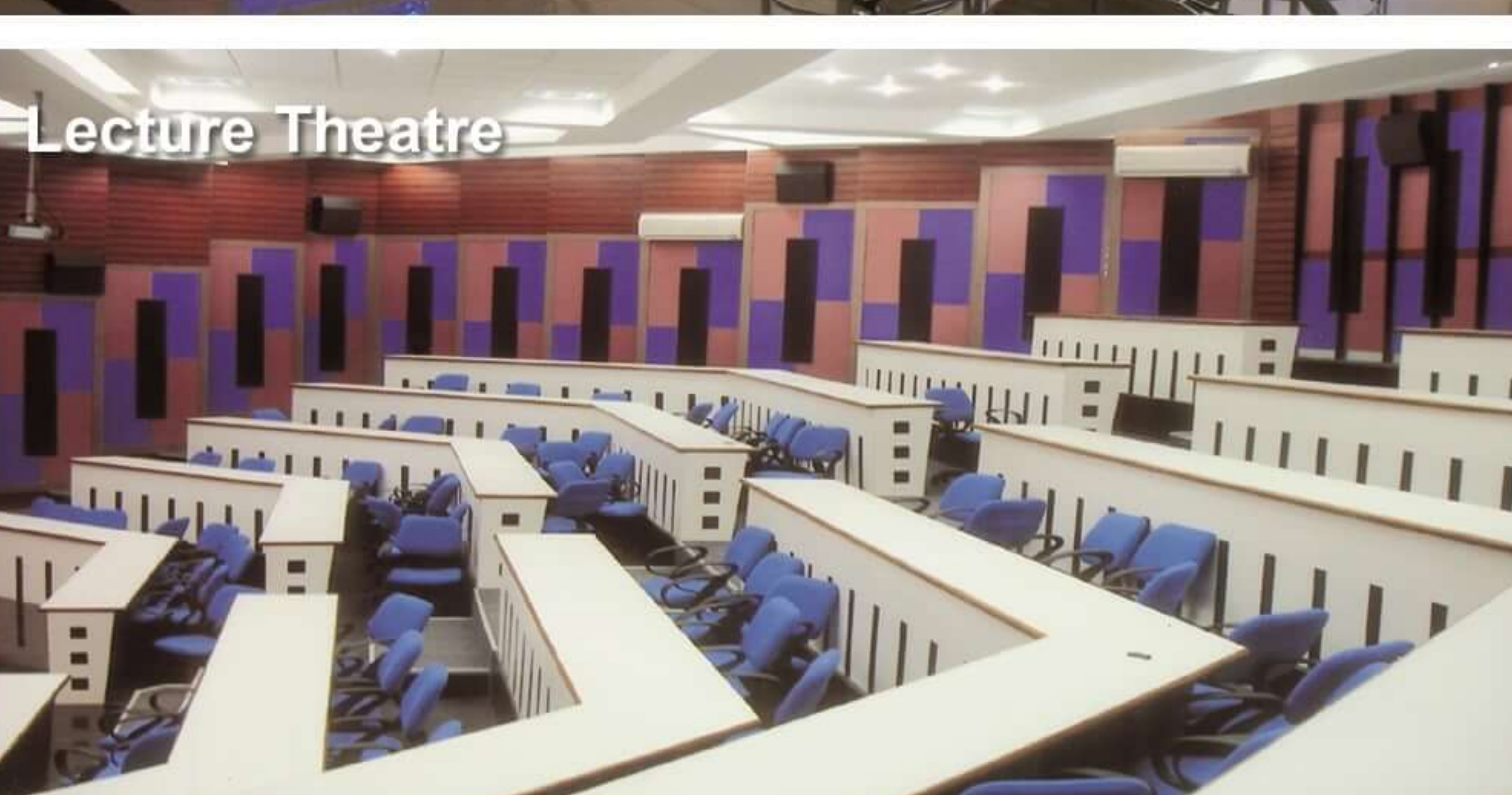

**CURRICULUM**

In 2006, the five years' programme for PIDC was approved by the Ministry of Higher Education which allowed an intake of 50 students. This has been subsequently raised to 75 per year in 2008. PIDC has been fully accredited by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency since 2010 and transformed its curriculum delivery methods to an outcomes-based approach from a traditional one, employing a variety of teaching-learning methods that include didactic or conventional approaches as well as active student participation such as problem based learning, teamwork, analytical thinking, self-directed and reflective learning. The BDS programme has been fully accredited for the maximum period of 5 years by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency. PIDC now looks forward confidently to the future to reach greater heights in its pursuit of excellence.

Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia (STPM)	BBB, ABC, AAC in 3 Subjects  i.e : Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Mathematics
SAM / HSC / CPU / CIMP/ MUFY / UNSW	Average of 80% in any 3 Subjects  i.e : Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Mathematics or 80% ATAR

Any other equivalent qualification recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) and Malaysian Dental Council (M.D.C)

SPM : Minimum requirement is 5 B's in Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Math and Add Maths. This is required to enable student to obtain a NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (N.O.C) from Ministry of Higher Education (M.O.H.E), Malaysia to gain admission into the dental programme.
